New Guidance for Day Care Centers: Today, the Administration issued new guidance directing day care centers to limit their classrooms to 10 people, including teachers. Additionally, day care centers should practice staggered recess and only feed kids in their individual classrooms. We'll provide a link in the evening update.

Small Business Administration Loan Program: The Commonwealth is coordinating with the U.S. Small Business Administration on the disaster declaration that will enable small businesses statewide to receive assistance through the SBA's Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program. Our application is finalized and the Governor is submitting the request to SBA today. We will notify the public as soon as SBA has approved our disaster declaration and the funding is available.

Donate Blood to the Red Cross: Many blood drives have been canceled over the last couple of weeks and there are severe shortages in blood supply. If you're interested and able, the Red Cross has a [number of sites across Virginia](#) that are open and safe to visit. The Governor will be donating blood this afternoon.

Virginia Employment Commission

Adhering to the directives of Governor Northam and local governments, many of the Career One Stop Centers (Centers) are being closed to the public or are providing limited access to the public by appointment only. In the Centers, the Virginia Employment Commission (VEC) provides workforce services to job seekers and employers, as well as assistance with filing claims for unemployment compensation.

The VEC is seeing a marked increase in the number of claims for unemployment compensation due to Covid-19 impacts on businesses. Updated instructions for filing claims and answers to FAQs are on our website at www.vec.virginia.gov.

Fairfax County Public Schools **Student Meals**

Fairfax County Public Schools has added Willston Center, located at 6131 Willston Center Drive to the list of sites that that will be distributing grab and go meals. Beginning today, Wednesday, March 18th you may go between the hours of 11-11:30 and pick up a meal. FCPS Students and other county students under the age of 18 can receive one meal at no cost.
